TINY FLEA BIG PROBLEMS

Fleas are black and brown in color and are about one-eighth inch long. Fleas can carry several diseases, including typhus and plague. Fortunately, these diseases are rare and more commonly affect rats and ground squirrels. Fleas more frequently carry tapeworms that can be transmitted to cats, dogs and small children. The more common flea problems are less harmful, afflicting pets with itchy sores, infections, hair loss and leaving their owners with feelings of helplessness.

Pets get fleas through contact with other infested animals or from environmental sources. Unlike larger insects, you seldom see fleas until after they have infested the home and started ravaging you and your pet.

Fleas can be a year-round problem. They have the ability to remain dormant in the carpet for up to two years. The solution is to eliminate the carpet and upholstery as a breeding and feeding ground for the flea.

TYPICAL FLEA LIFE CYCLE

The life cycle of the flea consists of four stages:

- **EGG**
- **LARVAE**
- **PUPA**
- **ADULT**

To eliminate infestation it is necessary to break the life cycle.

Eggs, larvae and pupal cocoons are found indoors in such places as carpets, tiny cracks in floors and behind baseboards. Adult fleas feed on blood and infest pets with eggs which drop onto bedding, floors and carpets throughout the home. A female can lay up to 500 eggs in her lifetime. The eggs hatch into worm-like larvae that feed on blood, skin and crumbs in the carpet. These larvae grow into adult fleas in only 24 days and are then ready to feed on the blood of any pet or person that happens by.

HINTS FOR ERADICATING FLEAS IN YOUR HOME

- Vacuum the entire house weekly, including the cracks and crevices along walls, and in all upholstered furniture and areas where pets sleep and rest. Vacuuming will remove some amount of adult fleas, eggs and pupae.
- Take vacuum cleaner outside immediately after use. Remove used vacuum bag, place in a sealed plastic bag and discard in trash.
- Wash and dry pet bedding at highest temperature available.
- Have pet treated with an all natural flea control product.
